

## **2003 Deep South Lacrosse All-Conference Team Announced**

*April 23, 2003*

ROCK HILL, SC – Limestone College senior All-American goalie Matt Malloy was named Deep South Conference Player of the Year after leading the Saints to their sixth consecutive Deep South Conference regular season championship, while Catawba College coach Peter Bourque was named Coach of the Year after leading the Indians to a third-place finish and a school-record seven wins.

Malloy led the conference in goals allowed average and save percentage. He was a key factor in the Saints' defense, which allowed just 6.64 goals per game.

Bourque guided the Indians to a 4-2 conference record, the best in school history after going 1-5 a season ago.

Lees-McRae rookie Joe Wisneiwski, who was among the league leaders in assists per game, was named the Freshman of the Year.

Malloy was one nine Saints to make All-Conference; seven of those were first-team selections. Devan Spilker, attack, Jason Randolph, attack, Nick DeLonga, midfield, Nolan Heavenor, midfield, Nick Kobakof, defender, Clint Pitts, defender, and Malloy were all named first team selections. Spilker, DeLonga and Malloy are repeat first team selections.

Wingate University placed six members on the All-Conference team, including two on the first team. Catawba had three representatives, including two on the first team. St. Andrews placed two on the squad, including defender Peter Gut, who returns to the first team.

Pfeiffer placed defender Brian Mauck on the second team.

The Deep South Conference Tournament semifinals will be played Friday at Wingate University in Wingate, N.C. In the first game, top-seed Limestone will face fourth-seed St. Andrews at 1 p.m. In the other match, second-seed Wingate will face third seed Catawba at 4:15 p.m. The all-conference team and award winners will be recognized between games.

The Deep South Conference Tournament finals will be Sunday at 2 p.m. at Wingate University.
